Parents' Role and Responsibility

Lahore School of Learning has always taken students' welfare, safety and protection very seriously. Students have been taught how to keep themselves safe and healthy e.g. proper hand washing (much before COVID 19), prevention of molestation techniques such as the **No Touch Rule**, making LSL bullying free... The school will continue to upgrade and improve its systems.

To make our programme stronger some steps will have to be followed very strictly at home as well. Relaxations may become a potential cause for danger. These rules apply to all classes right up to O Levels.

- ✓ Latest model cell phones and other electronic devices are **NOT** a school child's right. These are favours that cause more harm than good. Use extreme caution in their availability to children. A device/laptop may be used only for Online Learning classes and assignments with parental supervision and monitoring.
- ✓ Students must be strictly forbidden to have social media accounts to prevent possible misuse and also exploitation by strangers.
- ✓ Parents must not allow children to post personal and family photographs and private information on any public forum/social media.
- ✓ Closely observe and monitor recreation time spent with friends, cousins and neighbours.
- ✓ Online games with violent and adult content e.g. PUBG should be seriously discouraged unless parents can provide close monitoring while the child is playing. Parents must first play the games themselves to discover the facts before permitting their children.

- ✓ Parents and students are not to maintain any kind of direct personal contact with LSL teachers and staff through phone, email, all forms of social media (Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, WhatsApp, BOTIM etc.). Parents and students must not receive or accept or respond to phone calls, emails and text messages from teachers under any circumstances.
- ✓ All previous and existing individual and group contacts must be **DELETED** or **BLOCKED** immediately.
- ✓ Parents or students must **NEVER** directly call teachers or other staff for any reason whatsoever.
- ✓ Students are allowed contact with teachers only during school hours in the classrooms.
- ✓ In case of an emergency after school hours, only parents and not students, may call the Principal or the Coordinators:
